Problem-based learning (PBL), which is a commonly used student-centred method of classroom-based education, has a vital role to play in laying the foundation of these skills among healthcare undergraduates.

The short course will look at both trigger development and the process of PBL in these perspectives.

- To develop triggers to stimulate reasoning and reflective skills among students.
- To develop supportive educational material to encourage reasoning and reflection.
