

SCOPING REVIEW WORKSHOP - PROTOCOL DEVELOPMENT & SEARCH STRATEGY

ABSTRACT

Increasingly, physicians are expected to work in productive, trust-based systems to improve patient and system outcomes. A trust is greatly needed. This study assesses the state of the literature on other health care providers, institutions, and data systems or technologies. Dimensions of trust considered, quantitative measures used, and opportunities for a scoping review. Peer-reviewed, English-language research articles were identified via a scoping review. Peer-reviewed, English-language research articles were identified via a scoping review. Search terms included "trust" along with "physician", "family practitioner", "family practice", "generalist", "general practitioner", "internist", "internal medicine", or "health professional," and plausible variations. Articles identified (n = 446), the vast majority focused on patient trust in articles examining physicians' trust, rigorous investigations of trust are impeded in their discussion of trust.
